CHEONG. – At his late residence, Sailor's Flat, Whroo, on the 29th May, the dearly beloved husband of Helen Cheong, after a long and painful illness. Aged 66 years.

Ah Cheong, who has followed the occupation of market gardener at Sailor's Gully, near Whroo, for some 40 years, died suddenly on Wednesday evening. He had been ailing for some time.

Cemetery records have a Luke Ah Cheong buried at Whroo 30 May, 1902, though no mention of burial is made in the newspaper.
