

Mrs Hester Berry

There passed away at Whroo on Friday last one of the very oldest identities of that place in the person of Mrs Hester Berry, mother of Mr Alf Berry and the late C. Berry.

Deceased, who was 84 years of age, had a fall in a small hole a few days before her death, and being of such an advanced age this seemed to give her a great shaking, and she passed away as stated, although having no actual injury.

The remains were interred in the Whroo cemetery on Sunday, a large number of friends joining the funeral procession.

The Rev. J. R. Walker officiated at the grave and Mr Medhurst had charge of the funeral arrangements.

Other references suggest Esther, rather than Hester, but Esther may have been her mother-in-law.
