On Saturday morning an accident happened at Whroo which resulted in the death of a child about two years of age, a son of Mr. Menon, junr, of that place. It appears from the evidence taken at the inquiry, held by Dr. Heily the same evening, that the little fellow was only absent from his home about five minutes, and when search was made he was found in a small waterhole close to the premises. When taken out life was extinct.

He was buried at the Whroo cemetery on Monday afternoon. The news will be a great shock for his father, who is at present absent at Hay, New South Wales.

John's father, Mr John Grant Menon operated a business manufacturing cordials at Whroo, and is also buried in the cemetery.
