I have only just heard of the melancholy news of the death of our respected townsman Mr James Sharp, a brother-in-law to Mr Lewis, which took place early this morning, June 11h. Mr Sharp injured his leg on Balaclava Reef some few days since, but it was not thought to be serious, and yesterday he was enabled to walk a little. Mr Sharp was about 43 years of age and has been amongst us for some four years.

**20 June, 1862**

Mr James Sharp was interred in the Whroo Cemetery on Friday last. The body was followed to the grave by a large number of the inhabitants of the district. The service was conducted by the Rev Mr F Nicoll.
